6. When you are happy that you have answered the questions to the best of your ability the digital recorder will be stopped.

## ***EXAMPLE CONTENT ONLY***

1. How would you say the following in Welsh?

**This section consists of 15 short statements or phrases in English. The candidate is required to translate into spoken Welsh.**

e.g.

Good Morning

May I see .....?

2. Answer the following questions in Welsh:

**This section consists of 10 questions in Welsh. The candidate should answer appropriately in Welsh.**

e.g.

Dach chi'n gweithio yn Wreccsam?

Dach chi'n siarad Cymraeg?

3. Introduce yourself to the tape in Welsh.

Give your name and give brief details of 3 subjects:

**This section requires that the candidate gives basic, predictable everyday information in sentences in Welsh by way of introduction to a member of the public/meeting.**
